

Ring Size guide



How to print

To get the accurate results, make sure this guide is printed on A4 size paper (8.27" x 11.69") and scaled to 100%. To check that the Diamond2[®] Ring band has been printed properly, take a ruler and measure the line below. It should be exactly 50 mm.



Spot your Diamond2® Ring Size

To find your Diamond2[®] ring size, use an existing ring that fits you well. Match the inside of that ring with one of the circles on the previous page. Place a ring that fits you over the circle making sure the inside of the ring lines up with the outside of the circle. If your ideal fit falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.

How to use the Diamond2[®] Ring band

- Cut out the ring band and follow the instructions as follows.
- On the ring band, make a slit on the dotted line, where indicated.
- Wrap it snugly around the base of your finger making sure the numbers are facing outside.
- Pull the pointer through the slit until it fits comfortably around the finger.
- With a pen, mark the point on the band where it overlaps, forming a complete circle.
- Compare the marked length with the circumference mentioned below each circle on the previous page to determine your ring size. If you are between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.
